Master Plan & Building Update.
The process is moving forward as we continue working with the Archdiocese and gathering information to assess the needs of our growing community. We have completed an assessment of our existing buildings, giving us insight into future maintenance needs and an objective evaluation of our

current facilities. A site survey has also been finalized, providing an accurate layout of all buildings, parking areas, the cemetery, and utilities. A Master Plan team has been formed to ensure broad input from our parish community. This includes representatives from both St. John's (Andy Weber) and St. Anne's (Kristin Orr). The team has met several times with an architect and will continue working through the planning process in the months ahead. This effort is not solely about constructing a new building. Rather, it is an opportunity to thoughtfully evaluate our needs, consider potential phases, prioritize space and parking, and develop a long-term vision for our parish. We have also received authorization from the Archdiocese to proceed with a feasibility study, which is expected to begin soon. This will involve working with an outside firm to assess our financial position and establish realistic goals as we prioritize phases of the master plan, including the possibility of a building to address our most immediate needs. We will continue to provide updates as the process moves forward. If you have thoughts or input, please reach out to your St. John's or St. Anne's representatives.
